1.1.1 Superbike-Coach course rules: "Road Skill Course"

Dear Participant:

The rules of the Road Skill Course (on public roads) are discussed below. Further rules may be provided by a third-party service providers. This document must be read, fully understood, and agreed by participants.

GENERAL RULES

Medical Insurance. All riders/participants shall provide their own personal medical coverage.

Motorcycle Preparation and Insurance. The riders/participants are responsible for the safety of their own motorcycles and equipment. Your motorcycle has to be registered and insured (except for the Track Drill course), meeting the legal requirements for road use. Superbike-Coach Corp. and their instructors do not check the safety of a motorcycle or equipment of the participants. We suggest that you have your motorcycle inspected at your garage/dealer before starting any course. Before you bring your motorcycle to our events, verify that it has a full tank of gas, the correct tire air pressure and, at minimum, a legally recognized tire profile, and properly operating brake system.

Safety Equipment. Participants are responsible for providing their own safety equipment. We strongly recommend using all of the following equipment: (1) an undamaged DOT-approved helmet is required; (2) one or two piece full zip-together leather or textile style riding suit, or leather/textile riding jacket and riding pants with protectors; (3) leather gloves with full wrist coverage; (4) riding boots that fully cover the ankle; and (5) a back protector is suggested.

Laws Regulations, Rules, and Policies. All applicable Federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations must be strictly adhered to during the course. You must possess a valid, current, motorcycle driver's license, and insurance. Furthermore, rules, regulations, and policies provided by third-party services, and Superbike-Coach must be strictly followed at all times during the course. You must be over 18 years of age. **A violation of any law, rule, regulation, or policy may result in the immediate termination of your participation in the course without further comment and without any refund.** All decisions of a coach or instructor are final.

ROAD SKILL COURSE

Riding on official roads: When you **following** the Superbike-Coach Coach/Instructor on public roads, you always have to obey to laws. The Coach/Instructor has no chance to check your correct your speeds and actions during you are riding behind him. If you go **ahead** of your Coach/Instructor on official roads , it's impossible for your Coach/Instructor to catch you up and/or to slow you down during ahead riding and when you are riding over the speed limit.

Waiver

The Superbike-Coach waiver is inherent part of this agreement and need to be signed of before you start the course. You have read, understood, and agree to follow these rules with your signature:
